<b>School Session Outline</b>	<b>Storytelling</b> Half Day Blackburn Museum and Art Gallery	<b>KS2</b>
<b>Curriculum links:</b> Literacy		
<b>Overview:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For the children to have the opportunity to listen to and learn some basic storytelling techniques</li> <li>• For the children to have a go at putting these ideas into practice.</li> </ul>		
<b>In more detail:</b> This session falls into two rough halves, in the first the children listen to stories told using different techniques and then the children have a go at putting them into practice.  <b>Content:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Meet and greet pupils and staff</li> <li>2. Housekeeping <span style="float: right;">05 minutes</span>            The children are divided into two groups:</li> <li>3. Listening to a story (I) <span style="float: right;">25 minutes</span>            The children work with one of the two storytellers, listening to their story. The focus is on speaking and listening skills.</li> <li>4. Listening to a story (II) <span style="float: right;">25 minutes</span>            The children then work with the other storyteller, listening to their story. As above, the focus is on speaking and listening skills.</li> <li>5. Telling their own story <span style="float: right;">40 minutes</span>            Finally, the children move upstairs to the Victorian Gallery and, using our pictures as inspiration, work in groups to develop and tell their own story.</li> <li>6. Pack up and leave <span style="float: right;">05 minutes</span></li> </ol>
